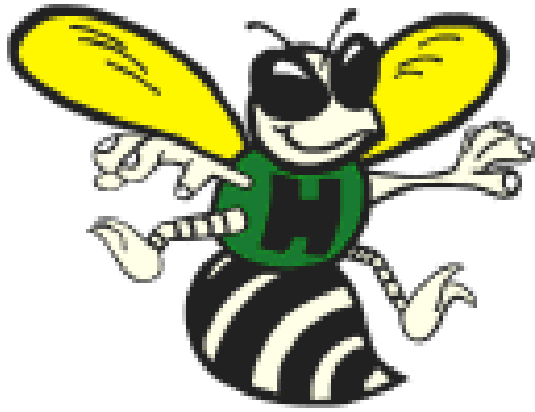

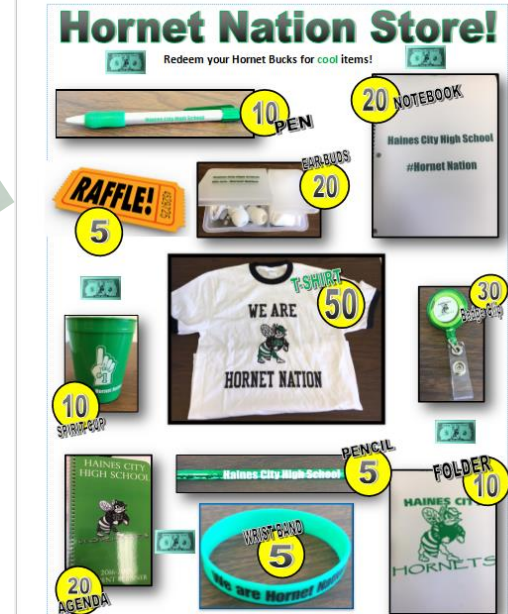

# What is working & What needs some work...

- **Going well-**

- Culture Shift- Staff are actively working to build relationships with student
- Students enjoy earning rewards that give them school experiences
- School data shows decrease in discipline, although population has increased each year

- **Needs some more work-**

- PBIS support is needed from more community members
- Expanding 'lessons' on school TV show – staff turnover affected creating videos this year
- More parent involvement and support needed

# Student Voice

- PBIS Class actively works on leading PBIS at the school
- Student created materials for implementation are used
- Students select what should be used in the school store
- Pizza with the Principal gives opportunities for students to directly share ideas and opinions
- Student voice has helped safety initiative at the school

# PBIS- Going Forward

- Seeking more community support
- School fundraisers to purchase PBIS items
- Expanding student training using school's TV production program
- Increasing staff buy-in with more staff recognition
- Increasing use of PBIS student leaders to be more visible in activities on campus
  - Broadening membership into this for students as a 'club' might generate more interest
